English 1 Learning Objectives (2008-2010)

1. Navigate and use the libraries both in-person and online
2. Find books, periodicals, and periodical articles in the libraries
3. Decipher periodical holdings statements and article citations
4. Use author, title, subject, or keyword search indexes correctly
5. Find articles and information in OmniFile and Literature Resource Center
6. Find hardcopy articles or full-text articles not at CCA
7. Differentiate between popular vs. scholarly resources
8. Compile a properly formatted bibliography
9. Quote and cite sources properly to avoid plagiarism
10. Evaluate resources for relevance, coverage, authority, accuracy, viewpoint, and currency
11. Utilize web searching when appropriate to the information need

Intro to the Modern Arts Learning Objectives (2008-2010)

1. Know how to use the online library tools for arts research
2. Find information on "proper noun" topics, such as artists, movements, building names, artworks, major events (usually singular in form)
3. Find information on themes and topics, such as genres, motifs, objects, concepts (often plural as a subject heading)
4. Create a network or web of resources on a topic
5. Select and articulate a viable research topic
6. Differentiate between primary and secondary sources; know what a scholarly peer-reviewed/referreed journal is
7. Make on the fly decisions about the worth and relevance of a resource
8. Find images on which to base or support research on the topic
9. Understand acceptable uses of images and other information
10. Properly cite images, online sources, and other irregular publication types
