OUR FUTURE MONTEREY

Dream to Reality Workshop Proposal

OVERVIEW

When you can imagine concrete details of a possible future, it's easier to close the future gap and put yourself into that future. -Jane McGonigal

Monterey's rich heritage represents the essence of evolution. First inhabited by the Ohlone Natives and secondarily founded as a Spanish Mission, Monterey has served as the capital of Spain's Pacific Empire, an Argentine and Mexican stronghold, and the Great Depression backdrop for Steinbeck's Grapes of Wrath. Known most recently as the 'Sardine Capital of the World,' Monterey has grown into a well-known tourist destination. It has substantial influence over the marine sustainability movement, higher education, and the military training economy. Monterey is a central hub of tourist-heavy locales such as Carmel-by-the-Sea, Pacific Grove, Santa Cruz, Big Sur, Laguna Seca, and the Monterey County Wine Country.

The aforementioned positive outcomes are not a coincidence. The city's leadership and active community involvement collectively guided Monterey to its current thriving state. As Monterey continues to build its next great chapter, external factors may challenge its realization. Elements such as climate and environmental change, the regional opioid crisis and accompanying crime statistics, city infrastructure, and economic challenges may complicate the city's positive trajectory. The accelerating pace, volume, and risk of such influencers requires cities to leverage historical context, expertise, and apply unique methods towards a desired future.

Imagine if you could get a glimpse of the future Monterey? Perhaps a suite of alternative futures? The good and the bad. How may it shape your strategy of attaining the desired Monterey of the future? How would such snapshots influence the way you plan and guide the projects, initiatives, and efforts which, in their totality, form the future Monterey?

This proposal outlines a proposal to work alongside Monterey to answer the questions mentioned above. Via a suite of collaborative efforts between us and you, the city of Monterey, the below recommends the goals and objectives, structure, and methods to set Monterey on a positive path into the future.

GOALS

We propose a 4-hour workshop, with the goal of enabling economic growth surrounding the tourist industry, increasing safety and affordability, and systemizing a way to vet future opportunities.

Given the time constraints of this proposal, it is paramount that we carefully balance expectations and establish precedence in approach. We believe new concepts are most applicable via a series of engaging experiences and conversations, where parties may converge and diverge. By design, we carefully order, time, and implement methods in a process which facilitates participant creativity, ideas, and confidence to share pertinent matters.

Our collaborative format incorporates the following four-phased process:

- 1. Build
- 2. Shape
- 3. Define and Prioritize
- 4. Decide and Apply

There is a familiarization component with the personalities, topics, and scope of the project. Furthermore, such factors as team composition, number of problem sets, topic complexity, and multiple points of view on singular topics require a broader goal measure. Upon completion of this initial consultation, Our increased familiarization with Monterey's team, issue scope, and positioning within the four-phase process will enable Us to be more specific in defining goals without sacrificing the ideation process.

OUTCOMES

Below are the objectives and desired outcomes associated with our four-phase process:

Phase 1 | Build

Collect a foundational understanding surrounding the city's issues:

- > Introduce and discuss topics which bring all pertinent matters affecting Monterey to the forefront
- > Conduct individual, small group, and large group thought exercises designed to increase substance surrounding Monterey's issues
- > Present tailored and immersive artifacts that engage the participants senses (hear, see, smell, touch) to uncover context, emotions, and sentiments associated with Monterey's issues
- > Incorporate role-playing exercises

Phase 2 | Shape

- > Clarify and organize that understanding to have strategic conversations
- > Consolidate, review, and identify issues requiring further discussion
- > Substantiate issues defined in phase one
- > Group issues into a logical format
- > Identify underlying themes
- > Set the stage for phase three and four work

Phase 3 | Define and Prioritize

- > Establish options and plans to address findings in phases one and two
- > Co-develop a prioritization schema based on criteria rooted in Monterey's goals

Phase 4 | Decide and Apply

- > Review findings across phases one through three
- > If necessary, update via incorporating new and pertinent phase one through three data
- > Affirm concepts, goals, and options

Next Steps | Collectively decide on course of action




> Location | Monterey Conference Center (MCC)






