About Annie Sprinkle:

Annie Sprinkle became a porn star at 18 years old in 1973 appearing in dozens of "golden era" 8mm, 16mm and 35mm XXX films. In 1982 she directed Deep Inside Annie Sprinkle, a feature fiilm which became a sex film classic and the 2nd best selling VHS tape that year. Bridging into the art world she made her own brand of "post porn" films, which played at many galleries and museums, including at the Guggenhiem Museum. She pioneered feminist porn, docu-porn, trans-porn, and edu-porn. Currently she is exploring ecosexuality and environmentalism with her partner/collaborator, Elizabeth Stephens. Currently Sprinkle is co-producing a new film with Stephens, Goodbye Gauley Mountain—An Ecosexual Love Story, due to be released May 2012. Sprinkle has been in sexually oriented media and art for almost 40 years, and was the first porn star to earn a Ph.D. She also works in theater, visual art, and performance.
